

Students in Action Volunteer Program



The Students in Action Volunteer Program is offered to college students seeking an advanced volunteer experience in health care departments, rehabilitation department, therapy departments, and administration departments, on a weekly basis, for 8 weeks. Volunteers are immersed in the department culture, to include performing 3 hours of daily department tasks, and 1 hour learning along with the LifeScape Professional, for a total of 4hrs per week. This volunteer opportunity advances college student's educational interests, builds confidence, creates networking, diversifies resume portfolio, and develops skill sets that prepare students for successful future career paths.

Students in Action Application Requirements:

1. Complete forms to be entered in the application pool. A selection process will identify placements for allotted openings. Not all that apply will be accepted. To apply, please submit: Resume and LifeScape Volunteer application to Rebecca.sluiten@LifeScapeSD.org. A Phone interview and tour will be part of the selection process
2. Students accepted will develop a schedule and are required to commit to a 4hr shift on a weekly basis, specific day/wk or adhere to schedule as identified by LifeScape department.
3. Summer Rotation runs 8 weeks (June– Aug)
4. Applications are due May 20, 2024.
